With Spencer Rogers as lead singer, guitarist and songwriter, Even The Sun has a commanding and confident frontman whose poetic verses ring through his personal tragedies and triumphs throughout the songs. After completing his first solo album, "Deeper in the Female," and performing live in the Los Angeles music scene, Rogers met drummer Ben Redfern, guitarist Bryan Davis and keyboardist Adam Grace and formed "Even The Sun" in 2004.

Los Angeles-based Even The Sun has played in legendary venues such as The Viper Room, The Derby, The House of Blues, The Knitting Factory, The Whiskey, The Mint and The Gig.

Even The Sun's first album, "Superspy," was self-released in 2006 and contains fan favorites: "Unknown Hottie," "Happy," "High," "Love Triangle," "What Happen To The Love" and power ballad "Fresh Out of Goodbyes."
